Soliciting & Petitioning

To comply with the First Amendment, the library allows petitioning, soliciting, and/or distribution of literature. The library does not advocate or endorse the views/opinions of groups or individuals soliciting/petitioning on library grounds.

Groups/individuals must abide by the following:

- 1. Cannot obstruct or prevent the public from entering or leaving the library or parking lot.
- 2. Solicitation/petitioning, is limited to outside the building.
- 3. Literature may only be distributed during normal business hours that the library is open.
- 4. Obscene/child pornographic content will be not permitted.
- 5. Responsible for the disposal of any literature.
- 6. Shall not engage in loud and raucous noise which is disruptive to library patrons.
